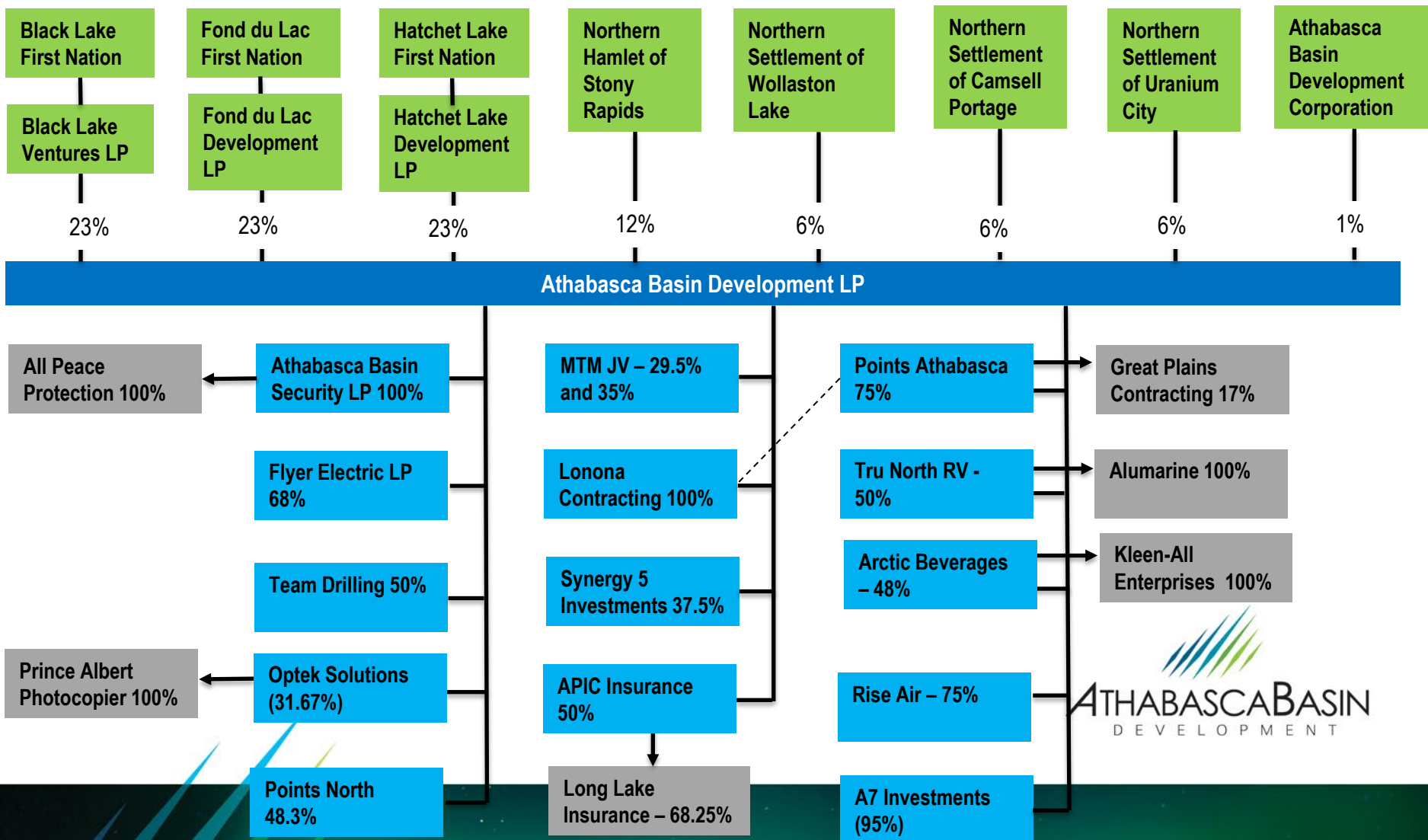


The original vision

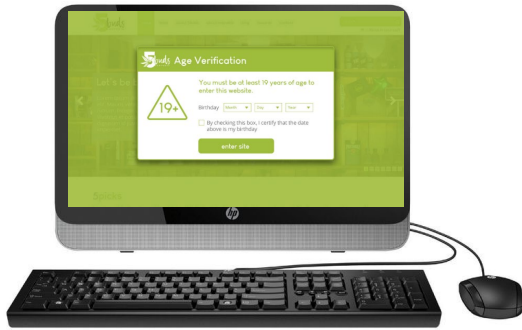

Indigenous Partnerships

- ABD and its investments collectively have ownership/partnership with nearly 40 Indigenous communities (directly and indirectly)
 - 33 in Saskatchewan
 - 3 in Alberta
 - 1 in Manitoba
 - 4 in BC
- For example, in Arctic Beverages, there are 17 different communities that have direct or indirect ownership

Athabasca Summer Student program

- Partnership with PAGC-Dene
- Employed 12 students in 2021
- Added positions in Athabasca communities this year & event.
- 18 positions in 2022; 16 in 2023
- Position examples:
 - Marketing/Communications
 - HR/Admin
 - Yard
 - Warehouse
 - IT
 - Accounting
 - Operations
