## What are Community Engaged Projects?

Community engaged projects provide opportunities for USask students to participate in a structured learning experience in partnership with community partners. These partnerships are driven by community partner priorities and provide reciprocal benefits to those partners and the students engaged with them.



## You might be interested if you are:

An organization (non-profit, for profit or government) or USask college, department or non-academic unit looking for support completing a 30-hour project that will have an impact on the community. Projects should also provide the opportunity for students to develop their career readiness competencies.



## What will students be expected to do through community engaged projects?

- complete a 30-hour remote project
- complete a 10-hour self-directed online course
- participate in a wrap-up presentation sharing their key takeaways from the learning experience or create a video sharing their experience

- Data Analysis
- Policy Review
- Social Media Content Management
- Data Collection
