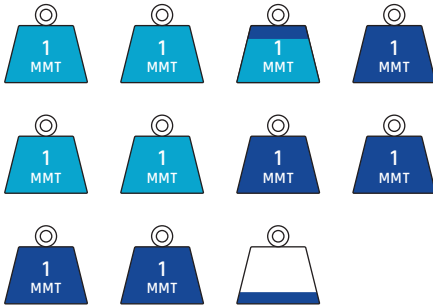
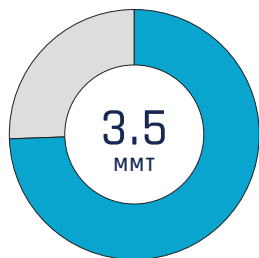


# Regina's Canola Opportunity



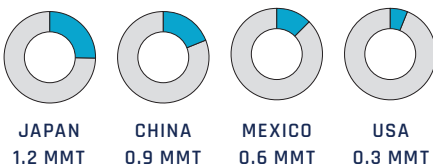
**10.2** MMT OF CANOLA PRODUCED IN SASKATCHEWAN IN 2019, OF WHICH 4.7 IS EXPORTED

**A big player:** Saskatchewan is the world's largest producer and exporter of canola seed.



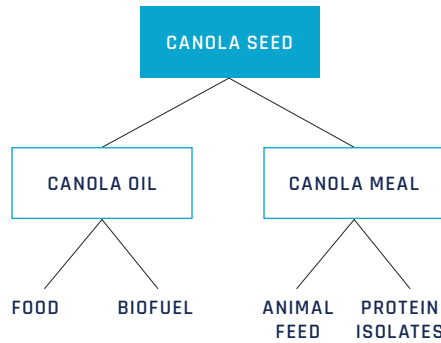
## REGINA

**A game-changer for Saskatchewan's canola sector:** The Regina area's two announced crushing facilities will create the province's largest single market for canola seed, comprising 1/3 of Saskatchewan's total 2019 production.

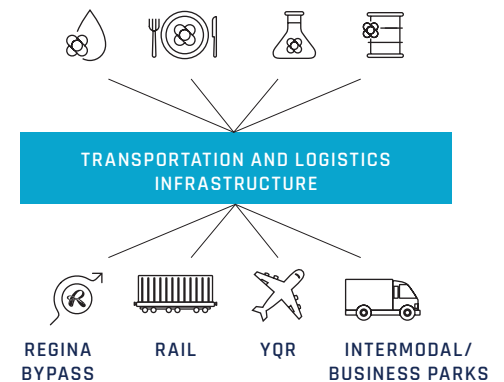
