Reporting to the Town of Eston CAO, this person would be primarily responsible for economic development & business relations for the Town of Eston and the RM of Snipe Lake.

Projects and Duties

- Facilitate the creation of an economic development strategy
- Identify business and economic development opportunities
- Oversee the Welcome Wagon program
- Manage the ordering and sales of all clothing and other 'swag'
- Coordinate the trade show every other year
- Organize approximately two business engagement events per year
- Oversee the Economic Development Board including meetings, minutes, coordination, and engagement
- Develop and implement a business attraction strategy including informational materials and tours
- Work on a business attraction plan for the region including zoning and incentives
- Conduct business visits and other activities to stay connected with businesses in the region
- Act as the primary point of contact for business and investment inquiries
- Maintain housing information for the community
- Update the business database
- Potential to assist with emergency preparedness planning
